This is a sentence. This is another one. The space in between the two is wider than the inter-word space.

An `abbrev. followed` by a normal space yields a wide space.

An `abbrev. followed` by “\ ” yields a normal space. This is what you usually want.

`U.S. followed` by a normal space yields the same space width as...

`U.S. followed` by “\ ”. This is because in “U.S.” the last letter before the full stop is a capital letter.

It's healthy to eat `Vitamin C. The` space afterwards is too narrow, though.

It's healthy to eat `Vitamin C. The` space afterwards is wide, as it should be in between sentences. This is achieved by writing “`Vitamin C\@. The space`” instead of “`Vitamin C. The space`” as in the example above.
